CornerStone was proud to be a part of this \$10M, 65,000 square foot project consisting of nine greenhouses. Featuring floors headed by radiant energy, cooling pads to hold plants that will be easier to clean, better water drainage, and a computerized system connected to real-time weather data that can be operated remotely, this was truly exciting to complete. The water re-use system collects approximately 38,000 gallons for every 1-inch of rain. Water is recaptured from the roof, stored in 80,000 gallon below-ground composite storage tanks and sanitized before irrigating plants allowing redistribution of water for year-round irrigation inside the greenhouses.
